John 17, 13 through 23

### **What is Sanctification?**

Answer! **To make Holy, or  
make free from sin.**

**Why should one be  
sanctified?** Answer!

Because of the sin  
committed by Adam and  
Eve, when they sinned  
against God, we inherited at  
birth, the same sinful nature  
they had, after they sinned  
against God.

To be restored to the same

holy nature they were in  
before they sinned,

**“We must be sanctified”.**

To receive sanctification,  
we must seek for it by  
**praying while asking  
Jesus to sanctify us.**

Every person that becomes  
sanctified, will know when  
sanctification begins to  
move into their body.

**The first evidence is the  
feeling of the flow of the  
spirit,** followed by one or  
more manifestations of the  
Holy Spirit, visible by

## **JOHN 3:16, BORN AGAIN (Saved)**

**Born again means  
regeneration, or brought  
into life or existence.**

When one is born again by  
the spirit of God, all the sins  
they've committed since  
birth, until they are born of  
the spirit of God are  
forgiven. **One is restored  
spiritually** to the same  
condition, as they were  
when their mother gave  
birth to them.

**The spiritual moving of  
Conviction and Godly**

**Sorrow draws one into  
the spiritual workings of  
Repentance.**

2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 7:10, For  
Godly sorrow worketh  
repentance to salvation----

**Godly Sorrow and  
Repentance brings on  
praying and tears, which if  
you continue praying, brings  
the New Birth.**

## **BAPTISM OF THE HOLY GHOST.**

## **TWO DEFINITE EXPERIENCES**

**Not Understood By most**

Before 1739 not much was  
known this side of the dark  
ages about the Christian  
experience known as  
**sanctification.**

Slowly bible scriptures on  
**sanctification** began to be  
revealed.

As it was revealed, this  
doctrine was preached to  
the masses and many  
received this wonderful  
experience **and accepted it  
as bible doctrine.**

The people were informed

*that they could not receive  
sanctification until after  
they had been converted,  
or justified, (born again)*

By 1740 it was being  
preached that **there  
were two** phases or  
experiences available to  
those who  
desired them.

**The first,** conversion  
(*justification or saved*) **the  
second, Christian  
perfection** called  
*sanctification.*

In the first experience the  
penitent was forgiven his  
actual sins of commission,

## **WISE AND FOOLISH**

Matthew 25, 1 through 12  
Then shall *the kingdom of  
heaven be likened unto ten  
virgins, which took their  
lamps, and went forth to  
meet the bridegroom.*

**And five of them were  
wise, and five of them  
were foolish.** *And they that  
were foolish took their  
lamps, and took no  
oil with them.*

**But the wise took oil in  
their vessels with their  
lamps.** When the  
bridegroom tarried, they all  
slumbered and slept. And

*at midnight there was a cry  
made, Behold, the  
bridegroom cometh, go ye

*Then all those virgins arose,  
and trimmed their lamps.*

And the foolish said unto  
the wise, *Give us of your oil;  
for our lamps are gone out.*

**But the wise answered  
saying, Not so; lest there  
be not enough for  
us and you:**

but go ye rather to them  
that sell, and buy for  
yourselves. And while  
they went to buy, the  
bridegroom came, and

revival was in progress. As I  
listened to the singing, I  
was amazed. Such singing  
and preaching, I'd never  
heard before.

**The preaching was with  
power like nothing I'd  
ever heard.** Something in  
their singing and preaching  
touched my heart.  
**I felt something I'd never  
felt.**

The Holy Spirit began to  
convict me of my sins. For  
the first time in my life I  
realized I had sinned  
against God and I wanted  
Him to forgive me. **When**

**the altar call was given, I  
knelt in the altar to pray.**

But I didn't know what to do.  
Then, others gathered  
around me and told me how  
to pray. As I prayed, a  
*crying spirit came upon me.*  
**I was consumed with grief  
over how I'd sinned  
against Jesus.**

This went on for some time.  
**Then I felt a peace enter  
my heart as never before.  
Jesus had forgiven my  
sins.**

It seemed to me that  
everyone in the church  
knew when I got saved.
